ALL I WANT FOR CHRISTMAS

We all have our favorite Christmas songs and carols that we love to hear and sing at this time of year. Some are quite old, some are new. A few years ago, Amy Grant had a popular hit written by David Foster called "Grown Up Christmas List." Perhaps you know it:

Do you remember me?
I sat upon your knee
I wrote to you
With childhood fantasies

Well, I'm all grown-up now
Can you still help somehow?
I'm not a child
But my heart still can dream

So here's my lifelong wish
My grown-up Christmas list
Not for myself
But for a world in need

No more lives torn apart
That wars would never start
And time would heal all hearts
Every man would have a friend
That right would always win

And love would never end
This is my grown-up Christmas list

This song originally came out 35 years ago, but it still expresses a very powerful longing in so many hearts today. There are things we desperately want; indeed – we need them. During this Advent and Christmas season we will be exploring some common aspirations during our times of worship. The first Sunday of Advent the message will be "All I Want For Christmas Is For God To Show Up." Week two will be "All I Want Is Some Good News." On December 15th we will have a special musical presentation that will focus on hope. The fourth Sunday of Advent will be "All I Want For Christmas Is a New Beginning." And, on Christmas Eve the message will focus on "All I Want Is Someone to Believe In." Included with these all December long will be familiar and favorite carols, Christmas songs, and hymns.

Throughout the season both the traditional and contemporary services will be offered, with two exceptions.

On the 15th, when we have the special musical program, we will have a combined service at 10:30 a.m. On the last Sunday of December (the 29th), we will likewise have a single combined service at 10:30 a.m. The first Sunday of the New Year we'll be back to our regular Sunday morning schedule.

So, let me encourage you to come out and celebrate the birth of our Savior and Lord, Jesus Christ. And be sure to invite a friend or neighbor, who may be spiritually searching or is looking for a new church home. People, in general, are very open to such an invitation during the Christmas season.

Let me share two additional opportunities for us this Christmas. First, our Missions and Outreach Team is partnering with BV West Elementary School to help 5 needy families from our area have a nice Christmas this year. A display with explanations will be up in Fellowship Hall beginning Sunday, December 1st. We ask that all items requested be returned no later than Monday, December 16, so that the school resource officer will be able to distribute them to the respective families before Christmas. Let's shine Christ's love for these families this Christmas!

Lastly, a Children's Christmas Party is being planned for Saturday, December 21 to be held in our educational wing. This is open to Bellpoint preschoolers through elementary age children. The purpose is to give parents an opportunity to do any last minute Christmas shopping or preparation with greater ease. The party will run from 10:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m., although children may be picked up as early as 1:00 p.m. We will provide a variety of activities, crafts, games, snacks, and entertainment. Please RSVP by December 15 through the church office. (This is a pilot program that we hope to offer the greater community next year.) Of course, parents are welcome to stay for the party if they'd like to.
