In three short weeks we will be celebrating the bodily resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. In this single and most important event, all the claims of Christ, concerning Who He insisted He was and the truths He taught, were resoundingly affirmed. As well our deepest needs for today and hopes for tomorrow were unquestionably met.

This year we will be offering an Easter Sunrise Service to be held at The Point at 7:30 a.m. It will last about 30 minutes. A continental breakfast and fellowship time in Fellowship Hall will follow at 8:00 a.m.

A full hot breakfast will be offered in Fellowship Hall from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Following at 10:30 a.m. we will have a full combined Easter Worship Service. In preparation for Easter we will observe Good Friday and offer a service of worship that evening at 7:00 p.m.
