If you hear of a concern or praise there are multiple ways to share the information with our Prayer Chain:

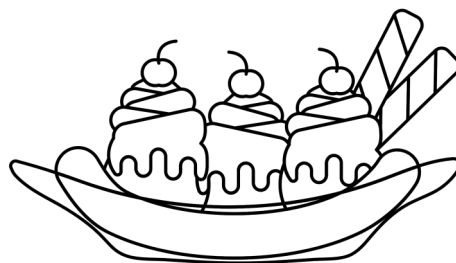
