### An Important Message About Our Church's Financial Health

Bellpoint Community Church family, we are facing a significant financial challenge and need your prayerful consideration and support. Our giving has decreased by approximately \$30,000 year-to-date compared to last year. This is a severe impact on our ability to meet essential obligations like payroll, utilities, and insurance.

To cover these costs, we've had to use our reserve funds, which were specifically designated for vital building renovations. This is not sustainable and jeopardizes our ability to maintain our facilities for both our ministries and the community groups that rely on us.

#### We Are the Church

Bellpoint Community Church is funded by the generosity of its members and visitors. Our collective giving ensures we can keep our doors open and our ministries active. The building and the dedicated staff who maintain it are essential for us to gather, worship, and serve. By supporting the church financially, we ensure a vibrant place for new members and our children to learn and grow in their faith.

The average weekly attendance is about 65 people. If each person were to increase their giving by \$17 per week, we could greatly reduce this deficit and be on track to meet our financial obligations.

As a reminder, 2 Corinthians 9:6-7 says, "Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver."

#### Next Steps and Ideas

We are confident that, with God's grace and your faithful partnership, we can reverse this trend.

Here are a few ways you can help:

- Consistent Giving: If you travel or miss a service, please consider making a consistent gift. You can easily set up automatic payments through your personal bank or on our church website.
- **Pledge Cards**: We will provide "Intent to Give" forms to help us better forecast our income. You can pledge a specific amount for the next 6-12 months.
- Share Your Story: We will be sharing testimonies of how Bellpoint has positively impacted our lives and community. These stories help connect our giving to the tangible outcomes of our church's work.

We ask each of you to prayerfully consider your current weekly offering. Please pray about how you can contribute, and feel free to reach out with any questions or ideas.

# **Prayer Chain**




### Sisters in Faith
