**GOD’S ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY**

Most students of music learn helpful tricks to identify the various notes on sheet music. For instance, the lines on the treble clef are E, G, B, D, and F. These are easily remembered by memorizing the phrase, “Every Good Boy Does Fine”. The spaces of the treble clef are F, A, C, and E. These are easily remembered simply by saying the word “Face”. These helps are called anacronyms.

When I was just beginning my walk with Jesus, over fifty years ago, I learned a helpful anacronym for an important part of The New Testament containing four of St. Paul’s letters to the church. Those letters are Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, and Colossians. The anacronym for these is “God’s Electric Power Company”. Although - I was reminded the other day by one of my colleagues in ministry that there is another: “God Eats Pop Corn”. While helpful, this second anacronym just doesn’t seem powerful or profound enough for what the Apostle Paul has packed into these books.

Beginning in February, we will begin a journey through these power-packed messages from St. Paul. Along the way, we’ll discover how our relationship with God and fellow human beings should be in order to help us live the kind of lives God requires of us; Spiritually, Socially, Physically, Emotionally, Psychologically, and more.

As we interact with God’s Electric Power Company I believe we will find new encouragement and strength to enable us to consistently live out the Christian life without compromise and with deep satisfaction and confidence, with boldness, peace and joy and an abiding sense of the power of The Holy Spirit, with the goal in mind of one day being able to declare along with Paul: ***“I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day.” (2 Timothy 4:7-8, NIV)***
