MISSION FAIR FEEDBACK

First, let me express my thanks for the wonderful turnout and support for our first Missions Fair, held on March 22nd. Approximately \$1,700 was raised that morning to help support the missions work of J, Dom Solli, and Emily Carpenter. We believe additional support was given directly to the three represented ministries. We are attempting to determine a grand total to share with the congregation as soon as possible.

We understand that several folks were absent from this event but perhaps would still like to give to this endeavor. Our Missions Committee would like to encourage those of you who fall into this group to prayerfully consider how you might contribute. Our goal has been to raise at least **\$3,000** for the year and to split it evenly between the missions served by J, Dom, and Emily.

With this hope in mind, a resource table with information for each respective mission will be kept up in the Fellowship Hall through the second Sunday of Easter. Please, be sure to stop by and check it out if you haven't done so already.

Concerning Easter and Holy Week - You'll want to note that we'll offer a **Good Friday Service at 7:00 p.m.** On Saturday, April 4th, the Children's Council will host an Easter Party for kids from Pre-K to 5th grade. Students & Wreaths

DACC students are doing something remarkable and it started with a simple question: what happens to memorial wreaths after they've served their purpose?

Now in its third year, a growing countywide partnership between DACC, Buckeye Valley Local Schools, Delaware City Schools, the Delaware City DAR, Delaware County Recycling and Litter Prevention through DPHD, and Ohio Wesleyan University is keeping more than 2,500 Wreaths Across America wreaths out of landfills.

DACC's Wildlife and Resource Management and Landscape Architecture & Construction students are participating in the effort, carefully disassembling wreaths so greenery, metal frames, and other materials can be responsibly reused or recycled with proceeds from metal sales going back to support veterans in Delaware County.
